Small Group Questions — The Week of May 30, 2021

Sermon Overview: At Park Cities Presbyterian Church, we say we exist to extend the transforming presence of the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ in Dallas and to the world. But what does that mean? What is the Kingdom of our Lord Jesus Christ? And how does His Kingdom transform us and the world? Join us this Sunday as we jump back into the Gospel of Mark and find out why there is no hope without the Kingdom, no Kingdom without the Christ, and no Christ without the cross.

Scripture Reading: Mark 8:27-9:1

1. What is the Kingdom of God? How does the Kingdom of God give us hope?
2. Where do you see a longing for the Kingdom of God in our world? In what ways do you long for the Kingdom of God?
3. Why can there be no Kingdom without the King?
4. Who did people say that Jesus was during His incarnation? Who do people say that Jesus is today? Who do you say that Jesus is?
5. What does the word “Christ” mean? What does this title tell us about the identity of Jesus?
6. Why did Peter rebuke Jesus? Why did Jesus rebuke Peter?
7. How did Peter respond to the cross? How does Jesus call us to respond to the cross?
