

## DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

*The following questions help us dialog with the sermon, music, and liturgy in this morning's worship service. Together, these elements provide space for reflection and prayer during personal devotions, group studies, and family worship.*

1. What does the word "LORD" refer to in the Old Testament? How does this shape the way we understand the word "Lord" in the New Testament?
2. Who spoke to Moses from out of the burning bush? Why is this significant?
3. How is the burning bush a picture of both the majesty and mercy of the Lord?
4. Why did the LORD come down to Moses? (See Exodus 3.8) Why has the Lord come down to us?
5. What name did the LORD use when He identified Himself to Moses? (See Exodus 3.14)
6. What name did Jesus use when He identified Himself to the Jews? (See John 8.58) Why did they pick up stones to throw at Him?
7. What does it mean to believe that Jesus is Lord? Why is this an essential element of the Christian faith?
