1.	What is significant about the specific location of this portion of Jesus' sermon?
2.	How would you describe the condition of our own souls that brings us to need this instruction from Jesus?
3.	What is a "present imperative" and why is it significant in these verses?
4.	What should we be ASKing the Father for when we ask, seek, and knock?
5.	What is important to understand about the parable/illustration of the persistent widow and the unjust judge? Luke 18.1-8
6.	Why does Jesus compare earthly fathers with the Heavenly Father? Why is this significant?
