The following questions help us engage with the sermon, music, and liturgy in this morning's worship service, and may be useful during personal devotions, group studies, and family worship.

1. Why are the disciples troubled? How would you describe the scene?
2. How are we to understand what is most significant about the place Jesus is going to prepare for them? Look ahead to John 14.23. How does this inform your answer?
3. Unpack Jesus' statement in John 14.6. How would you explain this statement to someone who has never heard it?
4. What is the significance of all the ways John is using the "In" terminology? What theological significance does this have in a believer's life? What do we call this reality?
5. Describe Jesus' relationship to the Father and why this is so full of hope for us who believe:
6. What are the "greater works" that the disciples will do? What does Jesus mean by this statement?
