4. Why does the promise of the Holy Spirit provide hope for the disciples?
5. What is the primary role of the Holy Spirit?
6. Why does Jesus call Him "The Spirit of Truth"?
7. What is the connection between the Holy Spirit's work and Jesus' description of the disciples love for Him seen in their obedience to His commandments?

8. As those who live in Christ, how can we expect to the Holy Spirit to be at work in our lives?
9. How would you describe the Holy Spirit to someone unfamiliar with who He is?
