3.	What is repentance?

5.	Why did the king of Nineveh issue the proclamation in verse seven?
6.	Why did the king's proclamation for a fast include the animals?
7.	What does God's response in Jonah 3.10 reveal to us about the nature and attributes of God?
8.	How does all the narrative of Jonah 3 give us the confidence, compassion, and courage to proclaim the gospel of Jesus Christ wherever He calls us?
