2. According to Paul's first petition in this letter, what does he believe the Ephesian need most? Why is this important?
3. How is the Trinity on display in this passage?
4. How do we receive wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of Him?
5. How does this prayer reveal what is essential to the hope we have been called to?
6. What prayers and practices help us grow in the knowledge of God?
7. What does Paul mean by, "Having the eyes of our hearts enlightened"?
8. Why must knowledge of God and knowing God remain together?
9. What are "the riches of His glorious inheritance in the saints"?
10. What prayers and practices have helped you grow in your knowledge of God?
11. What might be a next step for you to help you grow in knowing God?
