## Small Group Questions — The Week of September 27, 2020

**Sermon Overview:** What does it mean to be called? We all want our lives to mean something. We all want the work that we do to make a difference. When we consider our calling, so often we think in terms of occupation. But in the Bible, our calling is not just about what we do. Our calling is about who we are as disciples of Jesus Christ. Join us this Sunday as we continue our sermon series through the Gospel of Mark and find out what it means to be called by Jesus.

**Scripture Reading:** Mark 1:14-20

1. According to Jesus in Mark 1:15, what are the two aspects of genuine faith? Can you have one without the other?
2. What is grace? What does the call of Jesus have to do with grace? Why is grace so difficult for us to receive?
3. What did the first disciples do when they heard the call of Jesus? What did they leave behind? What does this teach us about discipleship?
4. What does it mean to follow Jesus? Can you be a Christian without following Christ?
5. Why did Jesus call the first disciples to become “fishers of men”? What does this term have to do with the good news of Jesus Christ?
6. What was Jesus called to do? What does this teach us about our own calling as His disciples?
