Small Group Questions — The Week of November 8, 2020

Sermon Overview: As large crowds come to Jesus, others are coming for Jesus. The tensions are growing as Jesus continues to reveal His power and the coming of His Kingdom. The religious leaders are plotting how to destroy Him and His family thinks He has lost His mind. Some see Him as the Divine Deliverer, others say He is demon possessed, and still others insist He is delusional. In the middle of it all, Jesus calls twelve men to Himself and appoints them as Apostles—sent ones. What did He appoint them to do? How will all these various groups of people respond? We have much to discover in these verses about our Savior and how the people responded to Him. Is it any different today?

Scripture Reading: Mark 3:6-21

1. Why were the crowds coming to Jesus?
2. What do you think this felt like to Jesus as a man?
3. Why did He order the demons not to make Him known?
4. Why did Jesus appoint the twelve as Apostles, and what did He call them to do?
5. How is your life in Christ a fulfillment of the mission Christ gave the Apostles?
6. How are you, as one in Christ, helping to fulfill the same mission?
7. How are people coming to Jesus today? How are they coming after Him?
