Small Group Questions — The Week of November 15, 2020

Sermon Overview: Some thought Jesus was crazy (His family) and others thought He was demon-possessed (religious leaders). In confronting these two false perspectives about His identity, Jesus spoke about the “unforgivable sin” and extended the definition of His family. As we come to the Lord’s Table this week, we come as family—His family. As we come, we will explore these two false perspectives about Jesus and celebrate His true identity as well as ours.
